Sungai Rukam Village is located within the Enok Subdistrict, which is part of the Indragiri Hilir Regency in Riau Province. It is situated within the Peatland Hydrological Unit Sungai Enok and Batang. Covering an area of 6,920.5 hectares, with peatlands spanning 6,316.8 hectares, which makes up 91.27% of the village's total area.

Indragiri Hilir is famously known as the "Negeri Hamparan Kelapa Dunia" or the "Land of Coconut Groves", with over 80% of its population relying heavily on coconuts for their livelihoods. Likewise, the residents of Sungai Rukam are significantly dependent on coconut farming. Notably, Sungai Rukam is renowned for its production of Virgin Coconut Oil, marketed under the brand name NIO, which translates to coconut in their local language.
